NOTES FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER

This year's Board of Directors election to fill three seats on the Board is now in progress with ballots going out to all Association members today. Copies of the four candidate's "Statement of Candidacy" forms are included in the ballot packet. Please take the time to review your ballot packet and the instructions carefully – then mark your ballot and return it by the deadline of 9:00 am on Sunday, June 3rd. Ballots will be tabulated the following day at the **Annual Membership Meeting** which officially begins at 1:00 pm in Casa Fiesta following the usual complimentary buffet luncheon which begins at 12:00 noon.

Please be advised that at the April 25th Board meeting, the Board directed the General Manager to notify all Hacienda Carmel employees that providing any type of "lift assistance" to residents, guests, or others will no longer be allowed. The reason for this mandate is to prevent possible injury to staff, or possible further injury to someone who has fallen and may be injured. Hacienda staff will be instructed on the protocols to determine whether a situation may require emergency medical responders, or a non-emergency call to summon professional help for a person simply needing help to get up.

BOOK SHOPPE


